Extracorporeal treatment for acute poisoning in Thailand

Extracorporeal treatment (ECTR) is one of the main enhanced elimination methods to remove toxins during acute poisoning. ECTR including hemodialysis is an important treatment modality for numerous poisonings such as lithium or salicylate poisoning. This topic describes the overview of ECTR available in Thailand and the clinical data of patients who required ECTR, especially hemodialysis, for management of acute poisoning by using Ramathibodi poison center database.
