CLINICAL CASE:

A male found lying by a small road is rushed to the hospital. Upon admission, he is in a coma and hyperventilating, showing no other abnormal clinical features. Despite supportive care, he dies the next day. The following day, three more patients are admitted: one in a coma and two with gastric upset and chest pain, blaming food from a wedding two days prior. One patient reports visual disturbances, and all are hyperventilating. They receive supportive care but deteriorate within hours. Meanwhile, a nearby health center reports two dozen patients from the same area being admitted, some in severe condition.


